2		One Double cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
3		One White cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
4		One Yellow cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
5		One Pink or Red cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
6		One Purple or Black cultivar, three blooms in one vase
7		One cv, any colour but not eligible for classes 3 to 6, three blooms, in one vase
8		One Lily-flowered cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
9		One Fringed cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
10		One Bicoloured cultivar, three blooms in one vase
11		One Viridiflora cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
12		One Parrot cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
13		One Darwin hybrid cultivar, three blooms, in one vase
14		One Kaufmanniana, Greigii or Fosteriana tulip, five blooms, in one vase
15 **		One Multi-headed cultivar, three stems in one vase
16 **		One Species tulip, five stems in one vase
17 **		One Species tulip, one pot or pan of at least 5 bulbs in flower
18 **		One vase of tulips, to be judged for diversity and decorative effect
